1 - Consultative Group of Experts (CGE)

Decision 14/CP.17

"Decides to continue the CGE under its current mandate as contained in the annex to decision 5/CP.15, and the work programme (FCCC/SBI/2010/INF.2), until the end of 2012".

- SB 36 (FCCC/SBI/2012/L.22)
 - ✓ Hands-on regional training workshops (e.g. for the Asia and the Pacific region: GHG inventories, Colombo, Sri Lanka, 30 Jan.-03 Feb. 2012; Mitigation, Bangkok, Thailand, 27 Feb.-02 Mar. 2012)
 - ✓ Development of e-learning programmes based on the revised CGE training materials
 - ✓ The SBI initiated, but did not conclude, consideration on the term and mandate of the CGE, and the need for the continuation of the group.



2 - Financial and Technical (F&T) Support

- SB 35 (FCCC/SBI/2011/L.33)
- ✓ GEF continues to provide information on its activities relating to national communications
- ✓ Non-Annex I Parties (NAIP) invited again to make submission on the detailed costs incurred, including in-kind contributions, for the preparation of their most recent national communications and on the financial resources received through the GEF
- ✓ NAIP encouraged to submit project proposals for the funding of their subsequent NCs before the completion of their current NCs
- ✓ GEF to continue to provide funds for **technical support** for the preparation of NCs, **similar to that provided by the NCSP**, and report on this issue at COP 19



Financial and Technical (F&T) Support (Cont.)

- ✓ UNFCCC secretariat requested to upgrade the software for GHG inventories from NAIP and make it available by June 2013
- SB 36 (FCCC/SBI/2012/L.23)
- ✓ GEF policy guidelines for the financing of biennial update reports for NAIP
 - (http://www.thegef.org/gef/guideline/biennial_update_report s_parties_UNFCCC)
- ✓ NAIP urged to submit their request to the GEF for support for the preparation of their first BUR (decision 2/CP.17, paragraph 41(d))
- ✓ GEF to be requested, by COP 18, to make available support to NAIP for preparing their **subsequent BURs**



Financial and Technical (F&T) Support (Cont.)

- ✓ GEF requested to make available support to NAIP preparing their BURs as early as possible in 2012
- ✓ GEF invited to provide, in its report to the COP, information on its activities relating to the preparation of BURs



3 - Article 12.5 of the Convention ("Frequency")

 By decision 1/CP.16, paragraph 60 (b), the COP decided that non-Annex I Parties should submit their national communications every four years.

 In addition, the COP, by decision 2/CP.17, paragraph 41(f), further decided that non-Annex I Parties shall submit biennial update reports every two years.

The SBI concluded consideration of this sub-agenda item.




4 - Biennial Update Reports (BURs)

- Decision 2/CP.17 (Annex III)
- Biennial Update Reporting (BUR) guidelines for non-Annex I Parties
 - ✓ Non-Annex I Parties should submit their **first BUR by December 2014** ("shall cover, at a minimum, the **inventory** for the calendar year **no more than 4 years prior to the date of submission** or more recent years if information is available")
 - ✓ LDCs and SIDS may submit at their discretion
 - ✓ Non-Annex I Parties shall submit a BUR every two years
 - ✓ GEF funding (\$352,000 + STAR allocation if needed)
 - National GHG Inventory: National Inventory Report (NIR)
 - Mitigation actions
 - Description of domestic Measurement, Reporting and Verification (MRV)
 arrangements
 - Finance, technology and capacity-building needs and support received



5 - International Consultation and Analysis (ICA)

- Decision 2/CP.17 (Annex IV)
- ✓ Modalities and guidelines for ICA (two step approach)
 - **❖** Technical analysis of BURs by a technical team of experts
 - ***** Facilitative sharing of views



✓ SBI item 5(b): Composition, modalities and procedures of the team of technical experts under the ICA (FCCC/SBI/2012/L.21)
