Background

- Decided in the COP24 in 2018, the Decision 18/CMA.1 obligates submissions of Biannual Transparency Report (BTR) from 2024 for both of developed and developing countries under the Paris Agreement Enhanced Transparency Framework (ETF).
- In the BTR, each party shall provide not only national GHG inventory but also information to track progress in implementing and achieving its Nationally Determined Contribution (NDC) under the Paris Agreement.
- With stronger transparency requirements put into place in 18/CMA.1, WGIA countries need to further improve their compilation capacity and national systems.
- The session IV in the WGIA17 covers information sharing and discussion about development of inventory data and systems for Inventories/BTRs of WGIA countries which would need to be submitted.
